

Kassie Bellaver will begin her sixth season in 2011 as head coach of the West Chester University volleyball program after coming off a 2010 fall campaign that saw the Golden Rams achieve a 23-12 record. The Golden Rams made their fifth straight trip to the PSAC playoffs in 2010, making Bellaver five for five in guiding the team to postseason play. The Golden Rams are 116-62 (.652) under Coach Bellaver.

The Golden Rams have achieved great success as a team in the past five seasons. In 2007, the Golden Rams raced out to a record 15 wins to open the season and end up tying the school record for victories in a single season with 28. West Chester finished 2007 with a 28-10 mark and went 24-10 in 2008. The team was ranked regionally for the first time in school history in 2007 and again in 2008 and 2010.

Bellaver's experience in coaching volleyball also extends to working with young athletes. She served as the head coach of the Beaver Valley Premier Junior Olympics program from November 1998 until May 2003, and has served as the camp director for the Economy Borough Summer Volleyball Camp since 1998. She also coached the Renaissance Junior Olympic Volleyball Club from November 2002 until May 2003 and served as an assistant volleyball coach at Center High School during the 1999-2000 campaign.
